

Conducting Town Business Remotely - COVID-19

The Town of Turner Board of Selectmen recognize that all residents are presently evaluating their acceptable levels of public interaction given the outbreak and relatively easy transmission of the COVID-19 virus. In consideration of the health and safety of our residents and staff, we offer the following alternative methods of conducting business with the town, most of which are accessible through the town's website, www.turnermaine.com.

Automobile Registrations and Renewals – For those with internet access, most vehicle re-registrations can be conducted online via the Secretary of State's Office. You will need your expiring registration, current insurance information and vehicle mileage. Please visit: <https://www1.maine.gov/online/bmv/rapid-renewal/>. Some new vehicle registrations can be done via mail. Please call us and we'll help you get it done.

Property Taxes – Property taxes can be paid through the mail, dropped in the mailbox to the right of the front door at the Town Office, or online. To pay online, go to the town website and click on the "Pay your Property Taxes Online" button at the lower left of the welcome screen. Payments may be made by electronic debit to a checking account or by credit card. Please call the office or send an email if you are unsure how much to pay.

Code Enforcement - For those with internet access, under "Departments", click on "Code Enforcement". All permit applications are available to print from the website. If you cannot access the internet, please email, fax or leave a voice message for the CEO.

Inland Fisheries and Wildlife is available thru our website under "Residents", click on "State Programs". This will bring you to Inland Fisheries website. If you cannot access this thru our site, the state site address is: www.mefishwildlife.com. If you do not have internet access, you can either email, or call and leave us a voice message. We will contact you as soon as possible, and help you complete your transaction.

Vital Records - if you need a certified copy of a birth, death or marriage, please email or leave us a voice message. We accept written requests, per a copy of your photo identification and payment. Marriage licenses may be issued vial mail upon receipt of notarized intentions. Please include the \$40.00 fee and documentation as to how the last marriage ended, if applicable. The marriage license will be returned to the parties by mail. Signatures can be obtained by the person performing the marriage when the marriage is performed. If you would like to print off the intentions form, download the form from our website. Click on "Residents", then click "State Programs", there you will find intentions forms (near the bottom).
